Harness and Other Protective Equipment:

Splint Boots/ankle boots (No bell boots please).

Collar pads **Britching pads** **Harness Saddle Pads**

Harness and Horse care:

Hoof picks **Halters (new or used)**

Lead Ropes **Grooming supplies (Brushes, curries, etc.)**

Leather dressing (Neatsfoot oil or the like) and leather cleaning supplies (soap, sponges)

Veterinary supplies: New only

Ivermectin-tubes **Panacur** **Wound care**

Farrier Supplies

Horseshoe nails **Farrier Tools (rasps, knives, etc.)** **Anvil**

Other: (Boot making supplies)

Velcro (Heavy duty) **Heavy duty Thread** **Neoprene**
